

Assessment of smolt index

Smolt index is assessed for fish going through the smoltification process. Smolt index is visually evaluated to estimate visible morphological changes related to smoltification in Atlantic salmon.

Assessment is done on euthanized fish immediately after being removed from anesthetic bath, and before other sampling or registration is done.

Criteria for smolt index

Parr → Smolt

Calculation of smolt index: Every fish is evaluated for parr marks, silver colouration and fin margins. The sum of all three factors are divided by three = final score for smolt index.
